



SOCIAL MOBILIZATION IS A RIGHT OF THE COLOMBIAN.

The World Secretariat of the Women's International Democratic Federation -WIDF-, meeting on May 22, 2021, on the massive process of National Strike in Colombia, resolves:

1. Reject the war treatment that the Colombian government of President Iván Duque has given to legitimate social protest, who has ordered the use of the full operational capacity of the public force to repress the protests and has militarized several cities.
2. To denounce the flagrant violations of the human rights of the protesters committed by the Colombian government, which in this month of May has claimed the lives of 43 protesters at the hands of the public forces, they have perpetrated 27 sexual and gender-based assaults, including rapes, they have damaged the sight of 33 people and more than a hundred enforced disappearances have been recorded.
3. To demand that the President of the Republic of Colombia, Iván Duque, cease the murders, disappearances, torture methods, sexual assaults on women, and other human rights violations.
4. To demand that the President of the Republic of Colombia, Iván Duque, accept the visit of the Inter-American Commission on Human Rights -IACHR-, in order to observe and verify the multiple human rights violations that occur throughout and width of the national territory in the framework of the protests of the National Strike.
