



77 YEARS AFTER HIROSHIMA, WOMEN DEMAND PEACE, DEMOCRACY AND SOVEREIGNTY FOR PEOPLES.

This August 6 we commemorate the 77th anniversary of the cruel and ruthless killing of human beings caused by the launch on Hiroshima, Japan, in 1945 of an atomic bomb of the Armed Forces of the United States, vile attack that claimed in a couple of seconds more than one hundred and fifty thousand victims.

On this day that we honor thousands of innocent people killed in Hiroshima, we urgently call for the mobilization for world peace of all the democratic forces of the world and we demand that the imperialist powers stop the war conflicts that affect all humanity.

We are currently threatened by a third conflict of global dimensions, and we cannot miss the commemoration of the Hiroshima massacre, to remind the world that it is the lives of human beings that die in wars, that wars aggravate the already deteriorated conditions of existence of the great impoverished majorities and the life of the planet.

In the face of the growing arms race, the resurgence of the threat of a global confrontation worries us that historically we are women and girls, the most affected by war, suffering displacement and forced migration, famine, violence in all its manifestations, human trafficking, sexual slavery, the loss of fundamental rights.

Already at the end of 2021, the number of people displaced by wars, violence, persecution, and human rights violations amounted to 89.3 million, more than double the figure ten years ago; Because of the Russia-Ukraine conflict alone, there are almost 10 million refugees or asylees spread throughout Europe, including Russia. These alarming figures reveal the serious escalation of war and violence in the world.

That is why we denounce the resolutions of the world elites of capitalism, led by the United States government adopted at the last NATO summit, which aim to deepen and globalize conflicts and expand their military bases on other continents.

To NATO, which seeks to show itself to the world as the sole representative of democratic values, human rights, freedom and respect for international law, with an air of environmental rescuers and "concerned" about a gender approach, we say that the interventionist war they promote and champion is far from respect for the sovereignty of peoples and that the

militaristic advances of those they boast, they do not promote peace, equity, or the elimination of poverty, nor do they reverse the serious damage to the planet.

We are sure that wars destroy any possibility of equality and justice for women. Women do not want to live fleeing violence, we do not want to be mistreated, nor raped, nor to be the spoils in the conflicts promoted by capitalist and colonized patriarchy.

That is why the FDIM denounces terrorism and fascism in all its forms and demands the complete dissolution of NATO and the elimination of its military bases around the world, demands that the governments of the world not lend themselves to be bases of support for any war, and urges the peoples to mobilize for a peace whose expression is not military might through the murder of hundreds of thousands of people, as happened in Hiroshima. We call to mobilize against war and in favor of life and peace.
